Title of the project:	Molecular mechanisms in plant-rhizobacterial interaction for abiotic stress tolerance
Duration of the project	3 years
Fellowship amount:	Rs. 31,000 + HRA (as applicable) per month for first two years and Rs. 35,000 + HRA (as applicable) per month for the third year.
Eligibility requirements	B.S.-M.S./M.Sc./B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent degree in biotechnology, life-sciences, biochemistry, plant biology, microbiology, molecular biology or a related discipline with at least 55% marks. Candidate should have qualified the NET/GATE examination. Hands-on experience in basic molecular biology techniques is desirable.
