

**Dx**

Cardiac (central) chest pain on exertion, relieved by rest or nitrate (retrosternal choking or constricting chest pain, comes on with exertion, relieved by rest or nitroglycerin, may radiate to jaw, neck or arms (more in left arm)).

**Key Investigations**

- ECG: The resting 12 lead ECG may be normal in 70 percent of patients; symmetrical T wave inversion is suggestive of coronary ischaemia (Fig. 1.1).
- ETT if resting ECG is normal
- CAG, blood sugar and lipid profile

**General measure**

- *Lifestyle modification:*
  - Stop smoking completely and permanently
  - Aim for ideal body weight (BMI 18.5–24.9 kg/m<sup>2</sup>)
  - Take regular exercise up to limit of tolerance, i.e. before onset of chest pain.

### ENTERIC FEVER

**Dx**

- Initially step-ladder pattern and then high continued fever
- Headache, malaise, cough, constipation
- Relative bradycardia, central coating in tongue, rose spots and splenomegaly.

**Key Investigations**

- CBC*—leucopenia with relative lymphocytosis
- Blood culture*—gold standard test
- Widal test*—rising titer or fourfold rise is significant.

**Mx**

- Diet—normal
- Tepid sponging SOS
- Tab. paracetamol 500 mg (1–2 tab 6 hourly if temperature is above 101°F) or paracetamol suppository 500 mg (1–2 sup 6 hourly)






