Description of the Project: The position of Field Investigators is to support fieldwork and data collection for an ICSSR funded Longitudinal Study, title of the project: Coastal Erosion: Adaptation Relocation and Rehabilitation in a Resilience Framework (CeARRRF). The study will examine the coastal erosion management approaches, across different social contexts in India to formulate a systematic approach that will be helpful at the national, state and local level.
