Terms of Reference (TOR) for Research Assistant

1. Description of the Project: The position of Research Assistant is to support research activities for an ICSSR funded Longitudinal Study, title of the project: Coastal Erosion: Adaptation Relocation and Rehabilitation in a Resilience Framework (CeARRRF). The study will examine the coastal erosion management approaches, across social contexts in India to formulate a systematic approach that will be helpful at the national, state and local level. The project is for a 4 years period, and is carried out by a multi-disciplinary research team from, BITS Pilani Hyd Campus, IIT Madras and Bhubaneswar, and AIIMS, New Delhi.

- **2. Place of work:** The Research Assistant will be primarily responsible for fieldwork in coastal district of a) Odisha (Kendrapara) and b) Tamilnadu (Villupuram).

- Developing research tools such as Questionnaires, Interviews and Focused Group Discussion schedule and prompts
- Conducting Surveys, Interviews and Focused Group Discussion
- Transcription of data and data compilation
- Performing quantitative and qualitative data analysis
- Preparation of periodic research reports, and academic manuscripts
- Maintaining project database and related records
- Coordination and liaising with other stakeholders including government agencies
- Any other project related task assigned by the Project Directors
