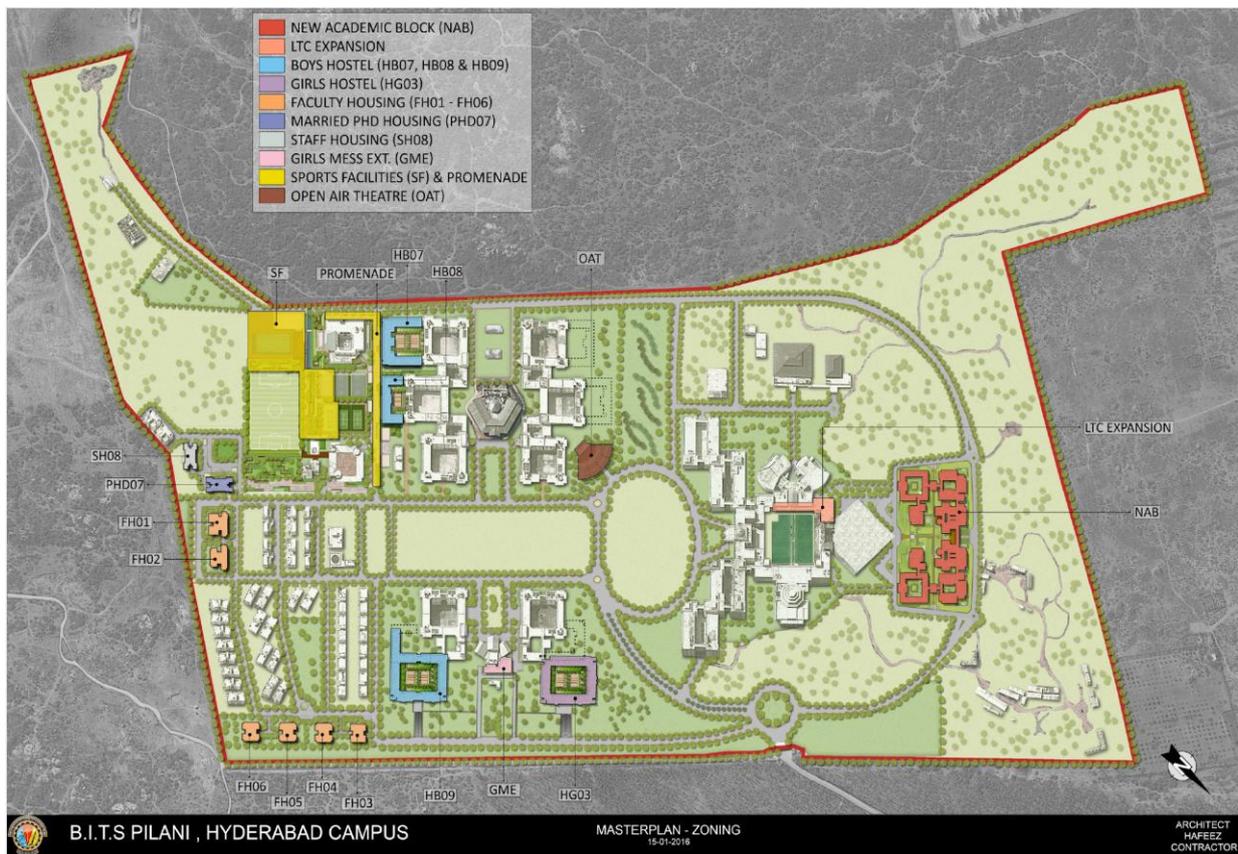

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Timetable Division

The Timetable and Examination Division at the BITS Pilani Hyderabad campus supports faculty, staff, and students by providing the following services:

1. Timetable Preparation

- Collecting teaching assignments from department HODs.
- Preparation of timetables for Semester 1, Semester 2, and the Summer Term.

2. Semester Registration

- Managing the registration process at the beginning of each semester.

Examination Preparation

- Handling course wise room allocation for examination.
- Assigning invigilators, group captains, and room captains for all exams (mid-semester, comprehensive, and makeup exams) for Semester 1, Semester 2, and the Summer Term.

Invigilation Duty Automation

- Using an email automation tool for sending invigilation duty sheets to instructors and ICs.

Makeup Exams

- Processing applications, preparing data, scheduling exams, and informing students who missed regular exams.

Online Room Booking System

- Managing a dedicated website for class room and reprography room booking and related approvals.

Timetable Software and Website Management

- Uploading courses, mapping faculty users, updating timetables, handling course changes, and managing file uploads.
- Overseeing room booking functionality (booking approval, duplicate booking checks, etc.)
- Maintaining the timetable website and handling admin controls and server management.

Classroom Maintenance

- Addressing classroom issues (lights, fans, ACs, projectors, etc.)
- Conducting regular classroom checks, especially during exams.
- Ensuring proper setup, including benches and signage during exam time.

Reprography Room Support

- Maintaining reprography machines across four blocks (C, D, I, K).
- Providing printing support during exams and regular days.

Store Room Management

- Distributing answer sheets for tutorials, quizzes, and exams.
- Preparing bundles with all required materials (sheets, thread, graph paper, etc.) and sending them to departments.

Assistance with Timetable Updates

- Posting updated timetables on notice boards and LMS.
- Updating ERP with revised timetables.
- Preparing seating arrangements and verifying IC/invigilation sheets for exams.

Support Services

- Responding to faculty and student queries via email and phone.
- Assisting other staff members with timetable and examination tasks as needed.

to biology, chemistry, pharmaceuticals, data analytics, machine learning, micromagnetics, and fluid and structural dynamics.

It is a heterogeneous system consisting of 42 compute nodes and 6 accelerator nodes, supporting both CPU and GPU parallel computations. It has two primary (login or controller) nodes to access the cluster, compile software, and submit jobs. Furthermore, it has two parallel file system (PFS) nodes for managing the read and write operations of a parallel file system. The cluster offers 264 TiB of Lustre space, excluding the redundancy. Overall, the HPC cluster has 5248 cores for CPU parallel computations. Currently, it delivers a peak theoretical performance of approximately 623 Teraflops.

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Practice School (PS)

Practice School Program provides students an opportunity to practice what they have learnt in marquee organisations under the supervision of a mentor. Students work on cutting-edge technologies and can choose to practice in their own discipline of study or cross-discipline areas. This flagship program not only nurtures students to work in roles needing multi-functional skills but also provides them an opportunity to secure a PPO.

Practice School I

Practice School-I is an eight-week course conducted during the summer term after the second year of study. Students are stationed in an organisation during this program, and after a comprehensive orientation, students primarily learn through observation and work on group projects under the guidance and mentorship of industry experts and a faculty member from BITS. This not only serves as a first exposure for students to the corporate world but also helps nurture their personality traits, communication, and presentation skills.

Practice School II

Practice School-II, offered in the final year of study, is a TWENTY-TWO weeks' full-time program. First degree students in their final year of study can register for this either during the first or second semester, and dual degree students can register for a double-semester PS-II program. For higher degree students, the course is titled Practice School, and such students can register for this during their final semester of study.

While students can opt for this program and give their preferences for the company where they wish to practice, the allotment of students to a particular company follows a merit-based allotment process.

Students get the opportunity to practice what they have learned by working on live projects under the supervision of industry experts and faculty members of BITS. This program provides students with the opportunity to put theory into practice, work on cutting-edge technologies, understand the company's work culture, and hone their behavioural skills. About 80% of the participating companies are long-term partners who depend on BITSians to build their talent pool. This speaks for itself about the performance of our students, which, in turn, is partly due to our curriculum and the stress on all-round development.
