As per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the guidelines issued by MHRD/UGC, Institute level committee, Institute level squad and Hostel level squads are formed to keep a watch on acts of ragging, and if any such act occurs, members of committee and squads are empowered to recommend punishments. In view of this, we all may note what constitutes ragging and what punishments can be given:

What Constitutes Ragging?

a) Any act of teasing or rudeness
b) Rowdy or undisciplined activities
causing physical or psychological harm
c) Asking the other to do shameful or
embarrassing act
d) Any act that provents or discupto

d) Any act that prevents or disrupts regular academic activity

e) Asking the other to complete one's own academic tasks

f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure

g) Any act of physical abuse

h) Any act of words, emails, public utterances causing discomfort

i) Any act that affects mental health and confidence of the other

A student indulging in ragging can be given following punishments:

a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges

b) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship /fellowship and other benefits

c) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation processesd) Withholding results

e) Debarring from representing the the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

f) Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel

g) Cancellation of admission

h) Rustication from the institution for the period ranging from one to four semesters

 i) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period
