<b>Principal Responsibilities</b>	<p>The Compliance and Data Protection Officer will be responsible for ensuring adherence to data protection regulations and compliance standards across all BITS Pilani campuses.</p> <p>Responsibilities for '<b>Data Protection</b>' include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>DPDP Act Compliance:</b> Ensure compliance with the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, and other legislations on data protection with a focus on secure handling of employee and institutional data.</li><li>• Conducting data privacy audits, impact assessments, and implementing remedial actions.</li><li>• Collaborating with the legal, IT, and compliance teams to update processes and policies.</li><li>• Providing training and awareness programs on data privacy for staff and students.</li><li>• Managing and responding to data subject access requests.</li><li>• Handling breaches of personally identifiable information (PII) and coordinating with relevant authorities.</li><li>• Developing and implementing the institute's data protection strategy, policies, and procedures.</li><li>• Advising on data protection aspects of new IT systems and procedures.</li></ul> <p>Responsibilities as a '<b>Compliance Officer</b>' include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Labor Law Compliance</b> (The Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952; The Shops and Establishments Act, 1948; The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947; The Payment of Wages Act, 1936; Building and Other Construction Workers Act; Any other relevant state and central labor laws, etc.)</li><li>• <b>Regulatory Compliance</b> Policies, guidelines, rules and regulations promulgated by MoE, UGC, AICTE, PCI, BCI, IoE, Public Trust, Section 8 Company, Society, etc. and Audits</li><li>• <b>Statutory Compliance</b> – Environmental, Safety, Pollution, Fire, Construction, etc.</li></ul>
