Principal Responsibilities	 Conduct 1:1 counselling session for academic performance, career planning, and personal growth. Guide students in career goal setting, industry awareness, and role selection. Help students manage stress anxiety, and rejection during the placement season. Support placement readiness through resume reviews, mock interviews, and group workshops. Facilitate academic improvement strategies including but not limited to, study skills, time management, exam preparation. Administer or interpret psychometric/aptitude assessments to provide structured guidance. Design group sessions and workshops on communication, workplace adaptability, ethics and leadership. Collaborate with the Manager Training, Placement Division and Faculty to align guidance with recruiter's expectations. Maintain confidential records, track progress, and prepare student development reports for review. Contribute to BITS CARES wellness and placement initiatives, ensuring integration with institutional goals.
