Applications are invited for the position of Junior Research Fellow (JRF) in the Department of Mathematics at BITS Pilani, K. K. Birla Goa Campus, Goa, for an ANRF-PMECRG Project sponsored research (File No. ANRF/ECRG/2025/003716/PMS, Title: Quickest Quantum Change-Point Detection (QQCD)).

Broad area of Research: **Operator Theory, Quantum Theory, Statistics**

Duration of the project: **3 years**

Fellowship Amount (Rs.): **37,000 + HRA as applicable**

Accommodation: Hostel Accommodation will be provided, subject to availability, and will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Institute prevailing at the time of the candidate's joining.

Eligibility: Candidates must have a postgraduate degree in Mathematics, Statistics or Physics with a first class (or at least a 6.5 CGPA) and a minimum of 55% marks in B.Sc. The candidates should have an excellent academic background and a sound knowledge of Linear Algebra, Real Analysis, and one of Functional Analysis, Quantum Mechanics or Statistics. Preference will be given to the NET/GATE-qualified candidates.
